- **NOSSCR.** NOSSCR's web site now has a link to background information about the debate over private accounts. The link, "Thinking About Privatization," appears on the NOSSCR home page, [www.nosscr.org](http://www.nosscr.org). The information on the site focuses on the impact of private accounts on people with disabilities.
- **CCD.** The Consortium for Citizens with Disabilities (CCD) Social Security Task Force has created a set of seven Fact Sheets to educate people about the impact of possible Social Security program changes on people with disabilities. The Fact Sheets discuss the following topics:

CCD encourages its member organizations (which includes NOSSCR) and others to share the Fact Sheets with their own members, elected officials and the press. Although the Fact Sheets were created as a set, people may use them separately to discuss an area of special concern.
